Course Objective

This class will give students the opportunity to use the English that they have already learned and to develop new ways of communicating. Because the lessons will be presented in a less formal style, students will risk making mistakes and therefore gain confidence in English conversation, By the end of the course, students will gain the ability to have extended conversations in a wide variety of situations.

Course Content

Students will interact with partners in conversation practice using skills acquired in English Conversation I. The class will be "student centered," meaning the instructor will assist while students converse with their partners for 80% to 90% of the class. Students will be paired with a partner for the entire class. Partners will be changed several times throughout the class in order to give a broader conversational experience. Because this is a conversation class, students will be expected to develop and express their ideas and opinions. Also, because most of the work will be done within the scheduled class time, students' attendance is very important.

Evaluation

Grading will be based on 3 factors:

- 1) <u>participation</u>—points will be given every class for the student's willingness to engage in the activities and conversations
- 2) <u>mid-term examination</u>—students will be given an oral examination that will require them to demonstrate their English skills in a group format
- 3) <u>final examination</u>—students will be given a more personal oral examination that will require them to have extended interactions with both the instructor and their partner
