### 【概 要】

As citizens of the world, it is important to have experience of different cultures in order to understand the range of perspectives and experiences that are possible outside one's own backyard. To be of service to our fellow humans, we must be able to communicate across cultures. Though you have studied English for six or more years, most of you have probably not used English very often. In Freshman English, we will focus on communicating naturally and effectively in English. You will gain the knowledge, skills and training that will help you to grow in your English language ability—both in and out of the classroom—for the rest of your life. Group work activities will give you the chance to help each other improve in English and also give you the chance to get to know each other better. You will have to think deeply and challenge your own ideas, and you may come to understand your own culture better through your experience of the cultural features of another language.

### 【到達度目標】

- (1) To acquire a range of vocabulary necessary for basic communication
- (2) To become comfortable discussing basic information in English, such as describing where you live, your family, your studies, and your hobbies
- (3) To become comfortable using English for various purposes, from asking questions about instructions to working with partners on group tasks
- (4) To be an effective collaborator in group work, making sure that you and your partners all get something valuable from each class activity
- (5) To become comfortable finding and understanding basic written information in English
- (6) To prepare and give presentations about basic information in English
- (7) To be able to communicate and understand basic ideas through various means, such as text messages and emails
- (8) To begin to take responsibility for your own learning, and to be effective independent learners

Class material will be developed and adapted to meet students' needs and abilities. As such, topics and sequence are subject to change.

### 【授業方法】

In this class, students will be expected to take responsibility for their own learning, to work well with partners, and to use English as much as possible. The teacher will not give lectures. Instead, you will use English in class to communicate with partners and accomplish tasks. Additional communication will take place via the computer.

授業は学生主体の形態をとるので、学生は各自の学習・課題に責任を持って取り組み、パートナーと協力し、可能な限り英語を使用する。追加的コミュニケーションはオンライン (moodle) で行う。

### 【学習到達度の評価】

- 1) Participation in discussions via the computer
- 2) Homework to prepare for class
- 3) Vocabulary quizzes
- 4) Active participation in class activities
- 5) Presentations
- 6) Speaking test

### 【評価方法】

- 1) Active participation (30 points)- You will be expected to maintain high attendance, ask questions, respond to the teacher and classmates, participate in pair and group work, take chances, help classmates and have a positive attitude.
- 2) Homework/Independent Study (20 points)- In order for you to be prepared for each class, it will often be necessary for you to complete a homework assignment, some of which will be given via the internet. If you miss a class, it is your responsibility to find out about the class work and homework so that you can do it before you return to class. In addition, at times you will be expected to work independently, making use of resources like the SALC and the internet.
- 3) Quizzes (20 points)- Vocabulary quizzes will be given on a regular basis.
- 4) Presentations- (10 points)- Presentations on basic topics will be given individually and in small groups.
- 5) Speaking Test- (20 points)- At the end of the semester, you will be given a chance to demonstrate what you have learned in an interview. If you get less than 60 points, you will fail the course. There is no makeup test for this course. If you feel you are in danger of failing, you must talk to the teacher and find out if additional work can be given.
- 1) 積極的参加 (30点) 質疑応答やペア・グループ活動での積極的、協力的な姿勢が求められる。
- 2) 課題、自立学習 (20点) 授業参加への準備として、宿題・課題の完了が必要。授業を欠席した場合は、欠席中の課題を調べ、次の授業までに準備すること。個人での学習、SALCやインターネット上の情報活用などを求めることもある。
- 3) 小テスト (20点) 定期的に語彙の小テストを行う。
- 4) 発表 (10点) 個人またはグループでの基本的話題に関する発表を行う。
- 5) 会話テスト (20点) 学期末に面談式テストを行う。単位の取得は60点以上とし、再試験は実施しない。単位取得に不安を感じる学生は教員に相談し、追加課題が許可されるか確認する。

### 【教科書・教材】

There is no textbook for this class. Materials will be provided by the teacher, and students will need an A4 folder to keep all handouts in order. In addition, many class assignments will be done on the computer, through moodle.

教材は教員が準備する。各自A4フォルダを準備し、配布資料・課題を保存する。また、課題の多くはコンピュータを使用する。

### 【履修上の注意】

Lateness: If you arrive after the start of the lesson, you are late. If you come to class late (up to 20 minutes) three times, it counts as one absence. If you are more than 20 minutes late, then you will be marked absent.

Attendance: If you miss more than one third of our classes (about 10 classes), you will fail the semester and have to repeat it. Please don't feel that you are safe if you miss only 3 or 4 classes. You could still easily fail because of all the work you would have missed. Missing many classes will also lower your participation grade.

When you are absent you must contact your classmates and find out about the class work and homework so that you can do it before you return to class.

It is important to remember that the end of a class activity is the beginning of opportunity for real English practice with classmates.
